

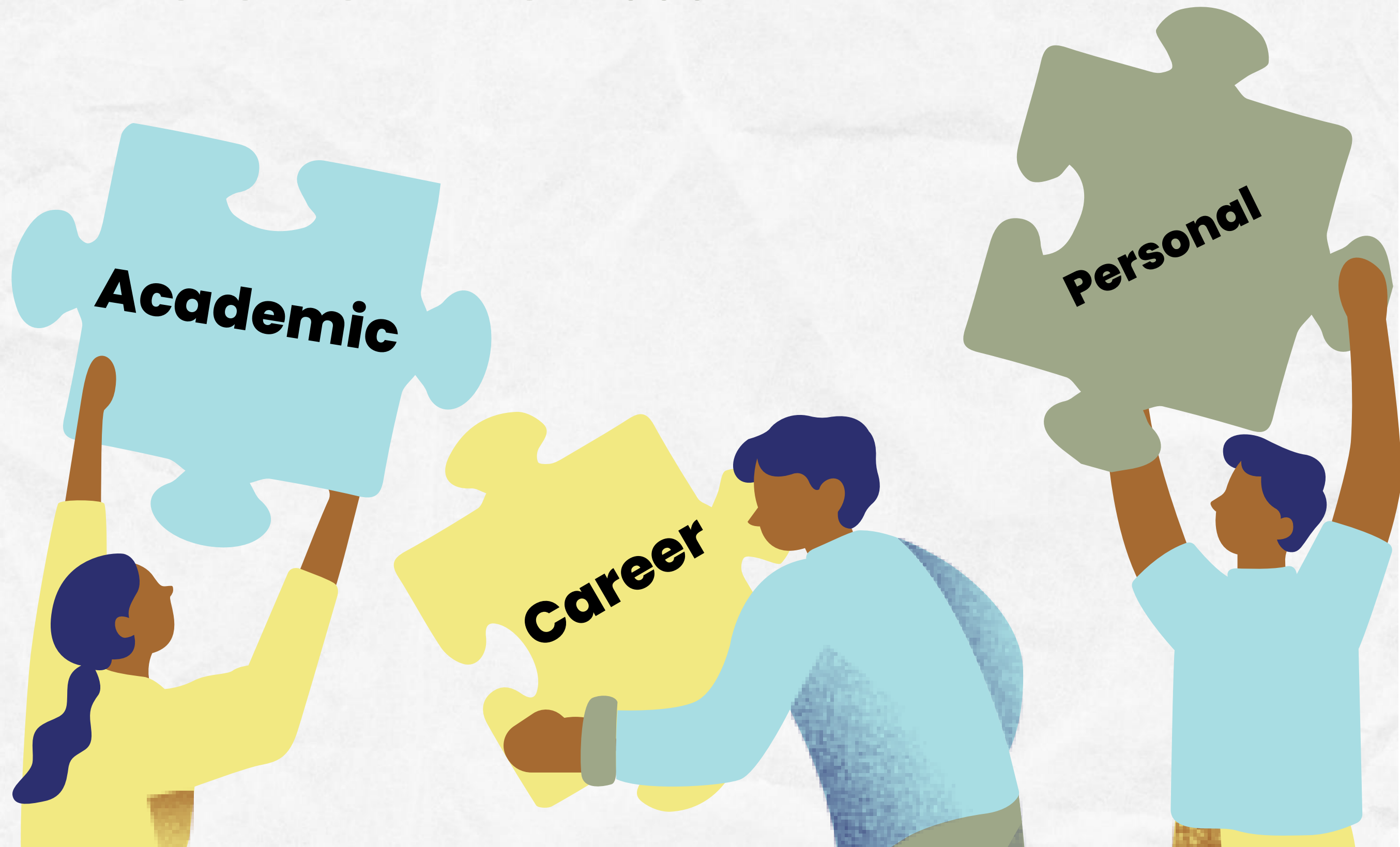

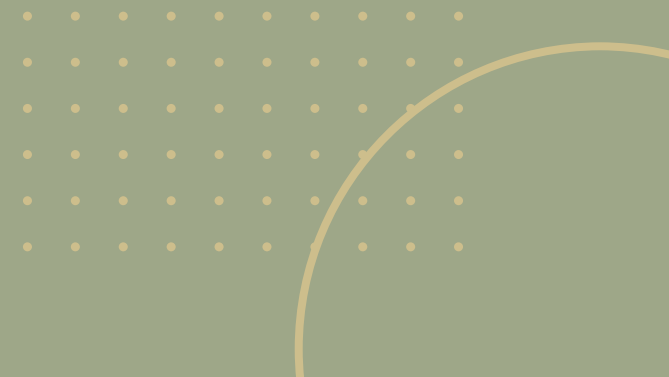

Graduation Requirements

Subject	# of credits needed
English	4 credits (9 th Lit, American Lit)
Math	4 credits (Algebra 1, Geometry, Advanced Algebra)
Science	4 credits (Biology, Physics/Physical Science, Chemistry/Environmental Science/Earth Systems)
Social Studies	3 credits (World History, US History, Economics/Government)
Health and Personal Fitness	1 credit
Career Tech/Fine Arts/Foreign Language	3 credits
General Electives	4 credits
TOTAL	23 credits

Of those 10 credits:

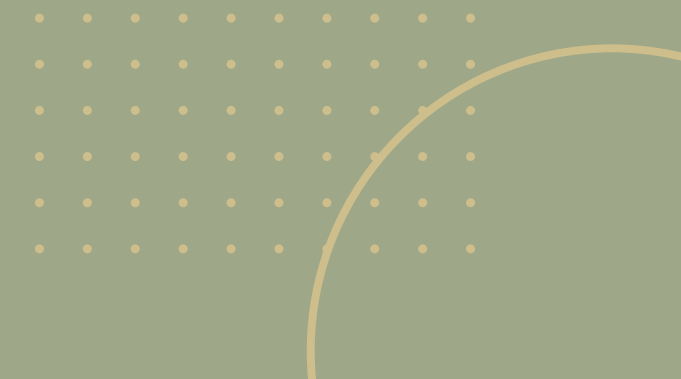
Must pass **2 required English**.

Reading Your Transcript



What's on your transcript?

- **Personal Information**
- **Cumulative GPA (ALL grades for every class you have taken)**
 - **weighted and unweighted**
- **Credits earned and attempted**
- **Attendance information**
- **EOC scores**

Cobb County transcript

- Cumulative Grade Point Average=
- The average of **ALL** grades earned in high school.
- Includes Electives (PE, CTAE, Fine Arts, etc.)
- Includes **ALL** grades (**PASSED OR FAILED**)

HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

- **Be a U.S. Citizen or meet non-citizen requirements**
- **Must be a Georgia resident for at least one year**
- **Must graduate from a Georgia High School**
- **Must pass 4 rigor classes**
- **Must have a minimum of a 3.0 HOPE GPA upon graduation**
- **Must have your SSN updated in CCSD student record**

HOPE Grant Program

HOPE GRANT

- **Be a U.S. Citizen or meet non-citizen requirements**
- **Must be a Georgia resident for at least one year**
- **No GPA requirement**
- **Test scores not required**
- **Eligible for students working towards a certificate or diploma at a technical college**

HOPE CAREER GRANT

- **Must be a recipient of HOPE or Zell Miller Grant**
- **Eligible for students working towards a certificate or diploma at a technical college in programs that are in high demand career fields**

HOPE GPA and Transcript

HOPE GPA= The average of your core classes (English, math, science, social studies), foreign language classes, and some computer science classes!

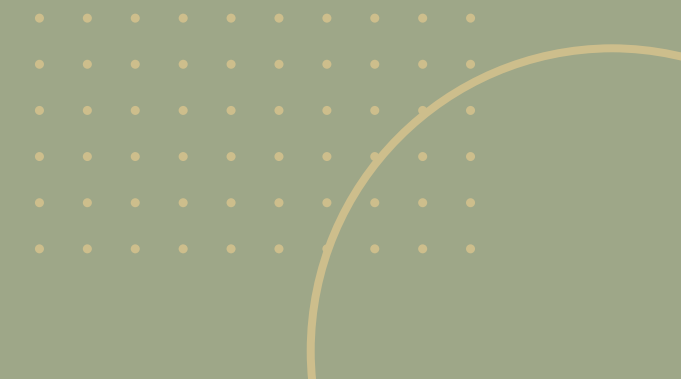
HOPE Scholarship Program

Some graduation requirements qualify as rigorous courses. As you are registering for 11th and 12th grade, keep these courses in mind. Example of rigor courses are:

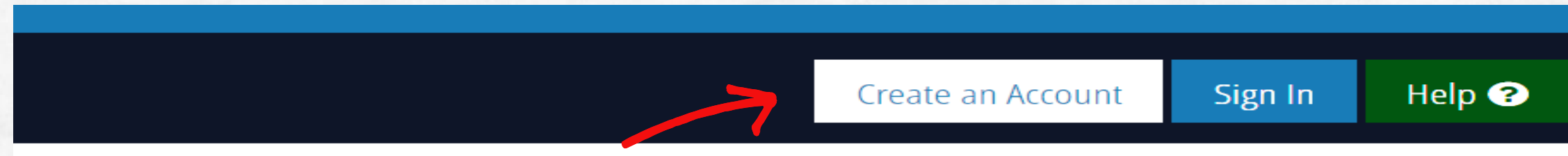
- **Math (Algebra II, Pre-Calc, AFA)**

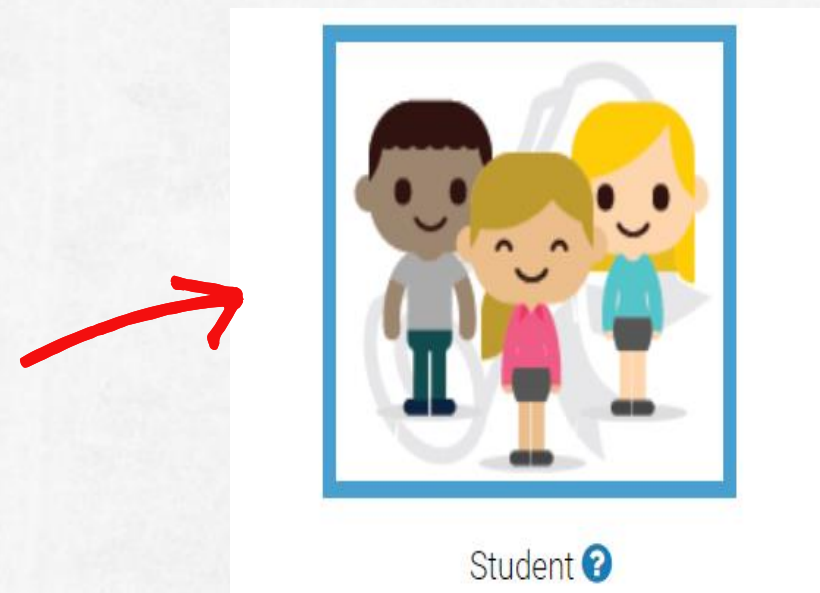



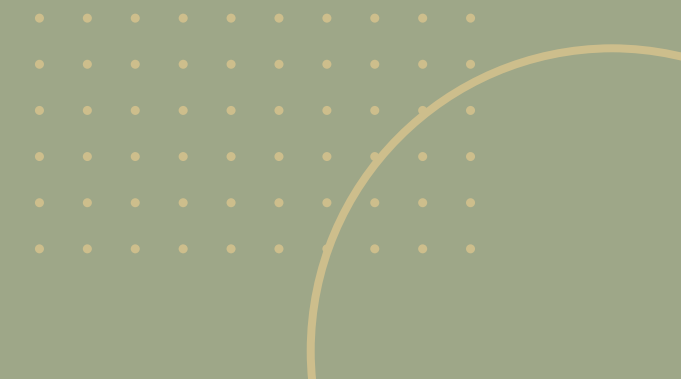

Testing



What are the SAT and ACT?

Why are they important?

The SAT and ACT are standardized tests that colleges use to determine how prepared you are to take college-level courses. Depending on the institution and your high school GPA, the college/university might require these tests for admissions. The SAT and ACT can also open the door for scholarships!



SAT

PSAT

Cobb County affords all 10th grade students the opportunity to take the PSAT. This exam is designed to prepare you for the SAT. You can also visit College Board to take additional practice tests!

To access your PSAT scores and register for the SAT, visit CollegeBoard.org!

SAT

You can register for the SAT through College Board. The test has 4 sections: reading, writing, math with a calculator, and math without a calculator. Keep in mind any deadlines when registering!

During your junior year, contact your counselor to see if you qualify for fee waivers.

ACT

PRE ACT

Some schools offer the PreACT to their students. The PreACT can provide insight into your performance on the ACT. You can also take practice ACT tests on ACT.org!

ACT

You can register for the ACT through ACT.org. The test has 4 sections: English, math, reading, and science. Keep in mind any deadlines when registering!

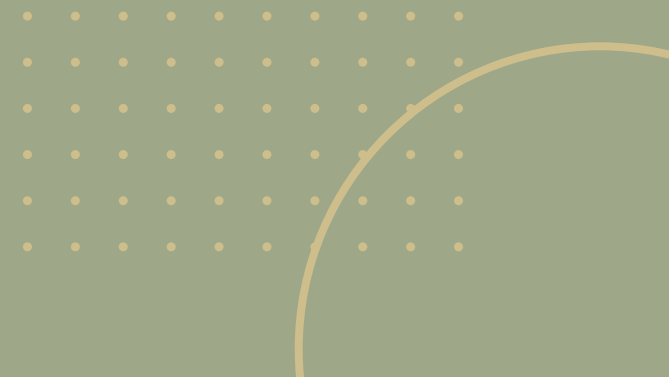

ASVAB

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is an exam that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military. This exam is available to *all* students who seek information about their skill set.

Dual Enrollment



What is Dual Enrollment?



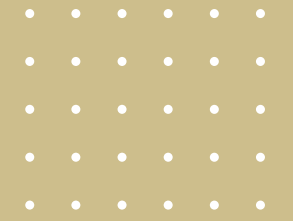
Dual Enrollment is a state-funded program that allows you to take college-level courses while completing your high school diploma.

This program pays for 100% of tuition, mandatory fees, and any required textbooks.

You can earn up to 30 credit hours!

Basically... You can earn college credits while still in high school!

Dual Enrollment



Dual Enrollment provides limited options for 10th graders.

1.

Any 10th grader is able to take a CTAE class at a Technical College.

2.

Those 10th grader who earn a 1200 SAT or 26 ACT (in one sitting) are able to apply to participating Dual Enrollment programs.

Dual Enrollment

Important things to consider...

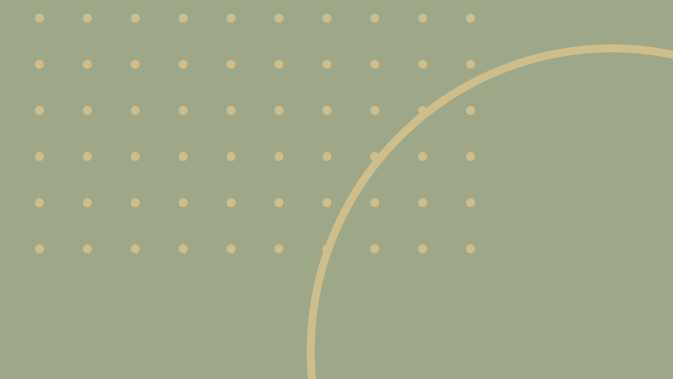
- **Will your college of interest accept these credits?**
- **DE vs. AP**
- **Full time vs. Part time participation**
- **Transportation to the college might be necessary**
- **Scheduling conflicts**
 - **In-school and extracurricular responsibilities**
- **Cobb County and College calendars are different**
 - **Breaks, exam dates, etc.**



Tasks from My School

Naviance Pathways



College: Associate's Degree

Earn an associate's degree or certificate in two years or less by attending a two-year community college or junior college.

College: Bachelor's Degree

Earn a Bachelor's degree in four years by attending a four-year private or public college or university.

Career Education or Trade School

Enroll in a short-term training program at a career or vocational-technical college and earn a certificate or associate's degree for an industry such as health care, cosmetology, and plumbing.

Apprenticeship Program

Enroll in an apprenticeship to get on-the-job training with classroom instruction and mentorship that leads to a skilled trade or profession.

Military Service

Enlist in a branch of the U.S. Armed Forces right after high school or join after college by enrolling in a Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) program.

Employment

Enter the job force right after high school to develop work skills and learn on the job without any formal training or education.

Undecided

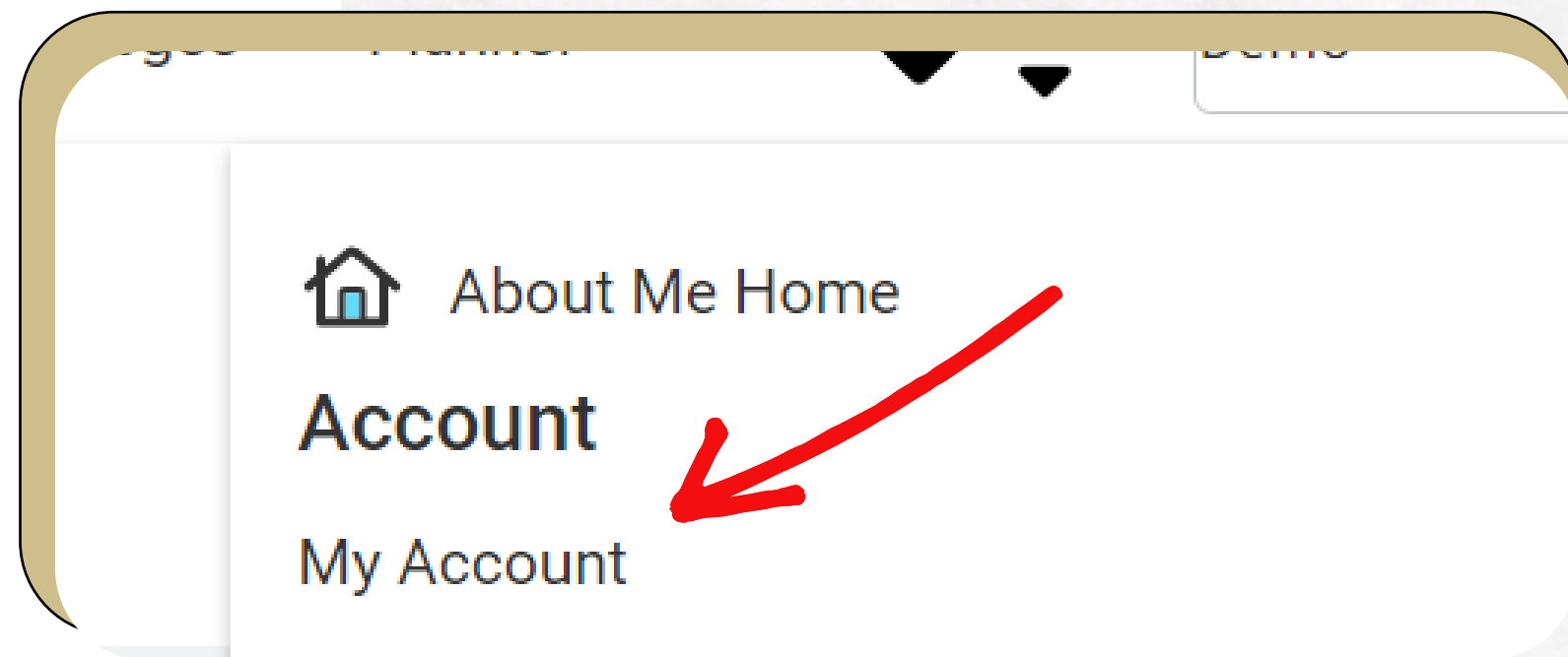
Not sure what to do after high school? Talk to a school counselor about different pathways to help decide what's best.

Gap or Service Year

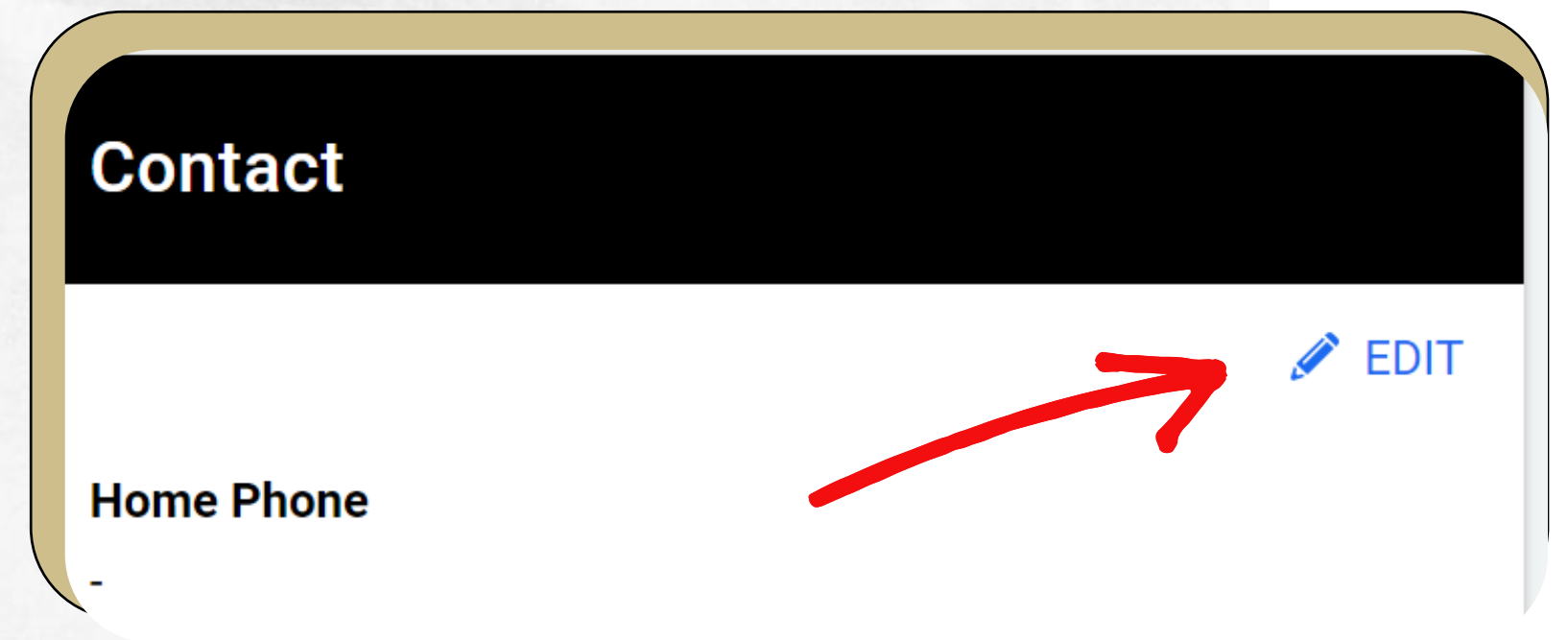
Take a gap or service year between high school and the start of my post-secondary path. Engage in service work, educational activities, or travel to give back to a community or to help decide a future goal.

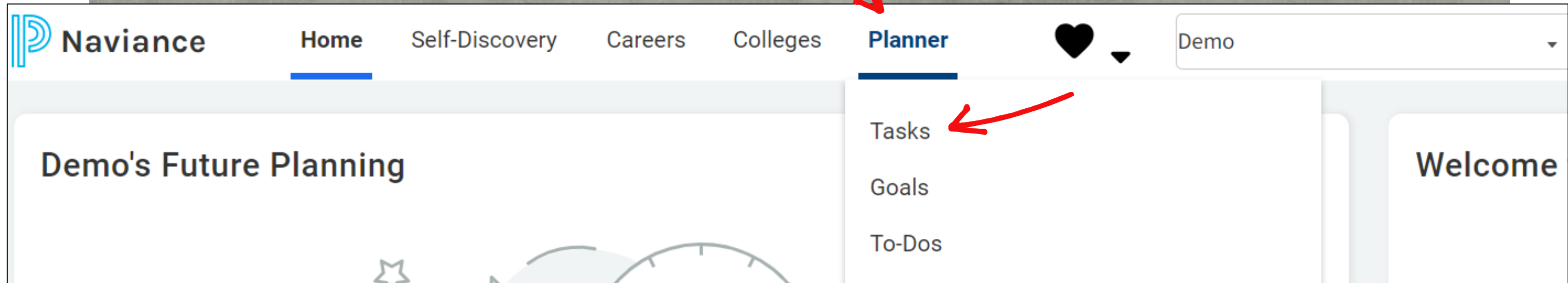
